Non-Toxic Wax Monitoring Block

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Piace ROBAN GOLD monitoring blocks where there are signs of rodent activity, both inside and outside buildings.
 Piace ROBAN GOLD monitoring blocks throughout the infested area. Only place one or two blocks securely at each monitoring point.
- 3. Place more monitoring points than you would place toxic bailing points to obtain a good activity profile of the rodents.
- 4. Protect ROBAN GOLD monitoring blocks from non-target animals and from water, preferably using commercially available balt stations.

 5. Fix the blocks in place using wire or a nail inside pieces of drainage piec, under sections of state, board or corrugated iron, securely weighted, just as you
- would for a toxic bait block.
- Make frequent inspections of the bait points.
 Careful examination of chewed blocks can reveal whether they have been eaten by rats, mice or even insects.
- 8. Prepare your rodent control program and site toxic baits such as ROBAN Wax Block Bait or ROBAN EXCEL according to the information gathered from the use of ROBAN GOLD.
- 9. Unused or damaged ROBAN GOLD monitoring blocks may be disposed of as non-toxic waste.
